Checklist

Why perform maintenance?

To keep your home running in tip-top shape it is important to remember to do routine maintenance on your new investment. Not only does routine maintenance prolong the life of your home; it is also shown to increase the energy efficiency within the home. The checklist below is meant to guide you on some of the routine items that should be checked, cleaned and possibly replaced throughout the year in your home.

Fall

Clean	Sep Oct Nov Change furnace filter
Quarterly	Annually
Test smoke/carbon monoxide detectors	Flush hot water heater and remove sediment
Test garage door auto-reverse	Apply winterizer fertilizer to your lawn
Run water and flush toilets in unused spaces	Get heating system ready for winter
Check water softener, add salt if needed	Turn off and flush outdoor water faucets
Give house a deep clean	Clear dead plants/shrubs from the house
Vacuum refrigerator coils	Check driveway/pavement for cracks
